With the isolation and limited social interaction during the pandemic, Cancer Support Community Arizona's (CSCAZ) services became more important than ever to address the emotional and psychological stressors that accompany a cancer diagnosis, including loneliness, depression and anxiety as well as physical, financial, workplace and social impacts. In 2020, Cancer Support Community Arizona pivoted to offer its more than 100 free classes each month virtually, bringing much needed support to participants safely in their homes, as well as increasing in-person navigator services to hospitals at the point of diagnosis and treatment.

Expanding into Northern Arizona

While COVID continued to prevent the full in-person opening of our expansion to Northern Arizona in Flagstaff, **CSCAZ Northern Arizona continued to develop partnerships which benefit those impacted by cancer** across the northern part of Arizona.

Dr. Cindy Payne was hired as the Director of CSCAZ Northern Arizona. A 30+ year veteran instructor at Northern Arizona University, Cindy is working closely with Regent's Professor Dr. Jani Ingram and the Native American Cancer Prevention Grant team at NAU and University of Arizona to benefit CSCAZ participants.

This includes 1:1 and family emotional support provided during hospitalization and after discharge. Direct resource navigation services include:


- assisting patient with health insurance coverage
