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IMPACT REPORT 2024



A Year of Connection, Courage, and Community

In 2024, Cancer Support Community Arizona marked 25 years of service—an opportunity to reflect on our roots and move forward to meet growing needs across our state. Cancer is touching more lives than ever, and our work has never felt more urgent or personal.

Together, we made powerful strides toward connection and impact:

- **In-person engagement surged.** We increased in-person program visits by 44%—from 4,960 in 2023 to 7,164 in 2024. Total participation reached 12,185, with programs like *Rise and Recharge*, *Cafecito*, and expanded support groups leading the way. This reflects a successful return to in-person connection while maintaining strong virtual access.
- **Participant feedback confirmed our impact.** In our 2024 participant satisfaction survey, 96% of participants said our programs helped in their cancer journey, 99% would recommend CSCAZ, and 78% developed friendships that extended beyond our doors.
- **Our voice reached farther than ever.** Through a coordinated media campaign, CSCAZ secured 243 media placements across TV, radio, and digital platforms—reaching over 86 million people and generating \$1.4 million in publicity value. This visibility helps more families discover the free support we offer.
- **We kept our mission strong through creative fundraising.** From a Taylor Swift concert raffle to bake sales and grassroots events, we engaged supporters in fun, meaningful ways—helping sustain our free programs despite rising costs.

None of this would be possible without you. Our volunteers, donors, partners, and friends are the heart of what we do. Your belief in our mission continues to lift and sustain us.

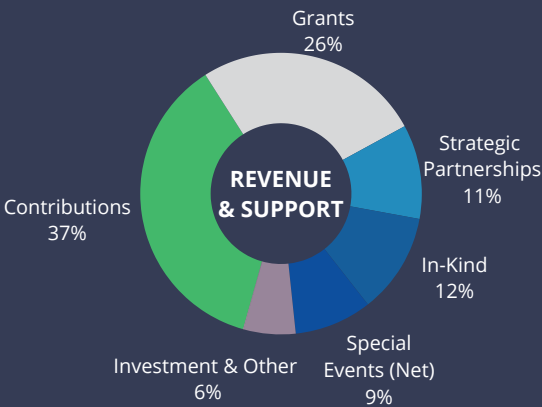

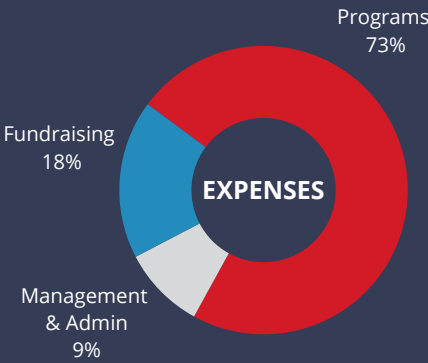

Highlights from the Year

Rise & Recharge: Innovation in Action

Launched in 2024, *Rise & Recharge*, presented by M3F—Music & Arts Festival for Charity, is a monthly, in-person event that empowers participants to choose from wellness classes, support groups, and educational sessions—all rooted in CSCAZ's five core pillars: Support, Resource & Referral, Healthy Lifestyles, Education, and Social Connections. Offered in Phoenix and Flagstaff, and in both English and Spanish, it quickly became our top in-person program.

With up to 85 monthly attendees and strong newcomer interest, Rise & Recharge inspired connection, healing, and hope. A clear example of innovation and compassion driving lasting impact.



Night of Hope - A Community United

In December 2024, communities gathered in both Phoenix and Flagstaff for *Night of Hope*—a heartfelt evening honoring those impacted by cancer. Under the night sky, participants created tribute ornaments, heartfelt cards, and ribbons for remembrance walls.

In Flagstaff, choirs sang, quilts were raffled, and blessings were shared in English, Spanish, and Diné. In Phoenix, s'mores and soup warmed hands and hearts. The evening closed with a moving tea light ceremony, each flame a symbol of love, memory, and resilience. Night of Hope reminded us that no one walks this journey alone.



Paradise on Palm Lane

We hosted a Homecoming-style dance in Phoenix in 2024 for teens ages 12–18 impacted by cancer. Whether facing cancer or supporting a loved one, teens came together for a night of connection, fun, and celebration.

With free dresses or suits, hair and makeup, a catered dinner, dancing, and swag bags, the event offered a vibrant space to make memories with others who understand.

More than just a dance, it was a chance for teens to feel seen, supported, and simply to be themselves.
